Job Summary:

General Production Worker is an entry-level position that may rotate between several manufacturing areas performing various job tasks.

The Normal schedule for 2nd Shift is Monday – Thursday, 2pm – 12:30am.

Currently, 2nd shift is working between the hours of 10am – 10:30pm, Monday – Thursday, staggered depending on the specific job/task.

Some of the tasks a General Production Worker may be responsible for:

- Check for accuracy: quantity, color, size, job paperwork, assemblies, and accessories
- Pack material for final shipment
- Correctly assemble items according to job paperwork and assembly instructions
- Load and unload production racks
- Inspect parts, identify unacceptable material
- Rack and unrack product carefully, per Stylmark's guidelines.
- Handle material per Stylmark's guidelines without damaging the material.
- Able to be cross-trained and rotated to other work areas as required by the Lead or Supervisor.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Ability to read, comprehend and remember part numbers and shapes from the Extrusion reference guide.
- Ability to read, comprehend and remember tags and extrusion specifications.
- Detail oriented and quality conscious
- Ability to select proper racking equipment and create racking/carrier configurations.
- Hand-eye coordination
- Ability to grasp and twist hand and wrists repetitively for extended periods of time
- Ability to lift and carry up to 40 pounds individually and with assistance over 40 pounds during the loading and unloading process
- Ability to push a loaded carrier weighing up to 300 pounds at an estimated 50 pounds of pushing pressure, getting assistance when needed.
- Ability to twist, bend, lift, and reach repeatedly
- Ability to work cooperatively and communicate clearly within the team therefore making the work of the group successful.
- Ability to work independently.
- Able to work a flexible work schedule and overtime as needed per the daily workload and/or as determined by the Lead or Supervisor
